

Amplify Youth Covid-19 Reopening Procedures

The following is an overview of the practices to be employed during the reopening of Amplify Youth for in-person gatherings on Thursday nights. The goal and purpose of this document is to outline guidelines and practices to be implemented in accordance with all Federal, State, and Local directives as made public by our governing authorities.

We believe that physically gathering is essential and necessary for the continued spiritual growth of our students. We also believe that gathering in person is the best way to carry out the vision of Amplify Church. We care deeply about the youth students that we serve and their safety, their families, our staff, and servant leaders. With the guidance provided to us, as well as the following implementations, we believe that we are equipped and ready to reintroduce on-site physical youth group meetings on Thursday nights.

Prior to Gathering:

- The theatre will be cleaned and sanitized on Thursday before youth programming begins.
- At risk youth or sick students are encouraged to remain at home and join us through our Instagram live feed instead of attending in person with us.
- In accordance with Governor Wolf's July 1st mandate, everyone is required to wear a mask at all times.

Arrival:

- Doors will open at 6:50 so students are encouraged to arrive around that time.
- Once at the door, a temperature will be taken of each individual. Anyone with a temperature of over 100 degrees will not be permitted to attend.
- We ask students to wait in line at a distance from each other until a seating team member can seat them at a responsible distance (siblings and other groups of students who have already come to church together are permitted to sit together).
- Students will not be marking their attendance via the ipad. Instead, leaders will take their own attendance in small groups.

During programming:

- Maintain social distance with others at all times.
- Follow the instructions of leaders in going to small groups. We will dismiss to small groups row by row.

Dismissal/pickup:

- If you drive yourself, follow the dismissal guidelines of small group leaders
- Parents who are picking up students should arrive by 8:30, and students must follow the dismissal guidelines of small group leaders.
- Students will be asked to exit in an orderly fashion from small group at a distance from each other, and small group leaders will monitor this process.
